## Commonwealth Solar

A new program announced today will help Massachusetts citizens install solar electric (photovoltaic or PV) systems on their homes and businesses.

Rebates for customers draw from existing funds for renewable energy, including \$40 million from ratepayer funds administered by the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative's Renewable Energy Trust and \$28 million from the Massachusetts Division of Energy Resources' Alternative Compliance Payment fund. This coordinated effort will lead to new clean energy generation in hundreds of communities throughout the state over the next four years.
