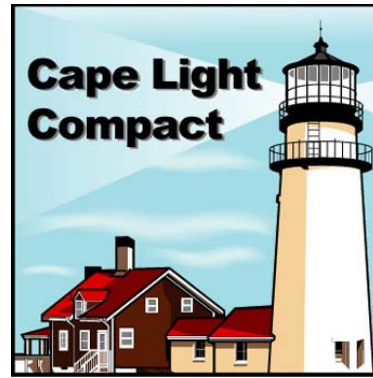

October 28, 2009 - Energy Conservation and Efficiency

Learn fun and exciting ways to teach students about energy conservation and efficiency measures and the economics of using them through the "Energy House" activity from the NEED Project. After our energy efficient houses are completed and tested, we will explore the world of the Energy Auditor by using tools of the trade to assess the energy efficiency of our schools and homes. State science standards will be addressed and a free energy conservation tool kit and lesson plans will go home with each teacher ready for use in the classroom.

November 18, 2009 - Renewable Energy

Using the popular KidWind (www.kidwind.org) activities and NEED (www.need.org) Solar and Hydro Energy Kits, come explore ways to teach about renewable energy and emerging technologies through hands-on experiments showcasing the power of wind, water, and sun! Teachers will receive a wind turbine, solar PV materials and "Frameworks" based lesson plans for classroom use.
