An energy audit must be performed or scheduled prior to payment of rebate. Rebate application must be filled out completely, signed and accompanied by dated receipts/invoices and received by Cape Light Compact and postmarked by April 30, 2010.

Eligible Heating Systems:

This Cape Light Compact rebate is available for oil or propane heating systems only. Please refer to www.thinksmarthinkinggreen.com for applicable rebates for natural gas heating system offers.

Installation Verification:
