Cape Light Compact is offering a rebate for residential customers to support the installation of a freewatt™ Micro Combined Heat and Power (MCHP) system in a residential setting. This rebate is **limited to 10 homes**, so please call 508-744-1277 for pre-approval.

Cape Light Compact has been, and will continue, monitoring the energy savings of residential freewatt™ applications for future efficiency program development. Upon installation of a residential system in a home, we periodically evaluate the natural gas consumption and electric energy use for one year.

Homeowners (must be primary year round households) will need to provide us with their natural gas consumption information for 12 months prior and 12 months after installation.

The Cape Light Compact, administered through Barnstable County, is made up of all 21 towns of Barnstable and Dukes counties. The Compact administers the regional energy efficiency program and works with the combined buying power of the region's over 200,000 electric consumers to offer competitive electricity supply, including a green power option, and other public benefits.

CAPE LIGHT COMPACT MCHP AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

REBATES: Subject to these Terms and Conditions, this program is offered by Cape Light Compact. Cape Light Compact will pay rebates to eligible customers of Cape Light Compact, for the purchase and installation of the equipment/products described in this literature and within this application.

CUSTOMER ELIGIBILITY: Equipment installed from 09/01/09 to 01/31/10 is eligible. It must have been installed at the installation address listed on this application and the required documentation listed must be received by the Cape Light Compact, no later than 02/28/10. Installer must be an enrolled dealer with freewatt™ at freewatt.com.

POST-INSTALLATION WORK VERIFICATION: The Cape Light Compact reserves the right to perform a verification of the specified installation. If the Cape Light Compact determines that the equipment was not installed in a manner that is consistent with program guidelines, the Cape Light Compact may require that the installation be modified before making any rebate payments. The cost of such modifications is the responsibility of the customer.

PROOF OF PROPER INSTALLATION: As part of its rebate application, the Customer is required to submit dated copies of all invoices documenting the installation (including all materials, labor and equipment invoices) which reflect the actual cost of purchasing and installing the equipment.

LIMITED SCOPE REVIEW: The scope of review by the Cape Light Compact and their Inspector of the installation of the equipment is solely to determine whether rebates are payable. It does not include any kind of safety review & should not be relied upon as one.

PAYMENT: The Cape Light Compact, expects to make rebate payments to eligible customers within 45 days of a satisfactory work verification. The customers must refund any rebate made to the extent the contractor or equipment does not satisfy program requirements.

WARRANTIES: Cape Light Compact does not endorse, guarantee or warrant any particular contractor, manufacturer or product installation.

CHANGES TO THE REBATE PROGRAM: Program is subject to change without prior notice, and rebate offers may increase or decrease at any time.

TAX LIABILITY: Participants of the program may be subject to tax liability for the value of goods and services received through the program pursuant to state or federal income tax codes.

NO TAX LIABILITY TO CAPE LIGHT COMPACT: Cape Light Compact is not responsible for any tax liability which may be imposed as a result of receipt of the rebates by Cape Light Compact to the customer.

LIABILITY: Cape Light Compact is not responsible for any loss or damage that may be caused as a result of the installation of the equipment.

CONTRACTOR INSURANCE: The Cape Light Compact is not responsible for any damage that may be caused by or arise out of an installation of any equipment. The customer is responsible for selecting contractors who are qualified and carry adequate insurance coverage.

EMAIL CONTACT: The email address provided on this form will be used by Cape Light Compact to send email messages pertaining to this program. Subject to regulatory restrictions, Cape Light Compact may share your email address with other Cape Light Compact programs. Cape Light Compact does not otherwise share or sell customer email addresses and will not disclose your email address to other third parties that may want to market other products or services to you.

ENERGY BENEFITS: Customer agrees that the Energy Efficiency Program Provider (EPP) has the unilateral right to apply for any ISO-NE capacity payments or environmental credits resulting from this energy efficiency project, and agrees not to file for such payments or credits either directly or indirectly. Manufacturer and/or retailer agree to provide the EPP with such further documentation as the EPP may request to confirm the EPP's ownership of such benefits.

REPORTING: Customer agrees to allow their natural gas bill usage to be reported to the Cape Light Compact by their natural gas supplier, National Grid Gas in Massachusetts. Please note, as electric program administrator, Cape Light Compact maintains customer historical electricity usage.
