Questions and Answers

- 1.) **Q: Does the Cape Light Compact (CLC) utilize a specific template for inspection reports that must be followed, or is the selected vendor expected to provide a template?**

A: CLC will work with vendor(s) to come up with a template format that is acceptable to both parties.

- 2.) **Q: Regarding Pricing in Section VII, is there a specific template that should be followed?**

A: No. CLC does not have a specific template but please be clear on which scope you're responding to and what your pricing includes – for instance whether a particular fee or rate includes travel. Please include assumptions that might affect pricing.

- 3.) **Q: Under what circumstances and frequency does CLC anticipate the deployment of leave in place metering? Will this be at the discretion of CLC or the selected vendor?**

A: Deployment of Pre and/or Post installation metering, and the length in which such metering trends should be collected, will be at the discretion of CLC, on a project specific basis, with the input of selected vendor(s).

- 4.) **Q: What is the anticipated volume of projects requiring engineering peer review?**

A: As these are ancillary services, the volume is not certain at this time. This depends upon the number of projects and the engineering resources available. It is likely that engineering peer reviews will be minimal in nature, perhaps a few projects a year.

- 5.) **Q: What database does CLC currently utilize for project tracking and management?**

A: CLC utilizes EECF (Energy Efficiency Collaborative Platform), a product of DirectApps, Inc. dba Direct Technology.
